LOCAL RULES

To aid in preserving the beauty and condition of our golf course, please repair all ball marks, rake bunkers, replace or fill divots with sand and place trash and recyclables in the appropriate receptacles.

Drop areas are defined by white circles across penalty areas on holes 6, 7, 8, 11, 16.

Sensitive Dune Habitats: These areas are defined by roping and signage. These areas are considered ground under repair from which play is prohibited.

Please keep carts on the path around tees and greens and on par 3's at all times. Power carts and pull carts must not enter any fescue areas.

All penalty areas are defined by colored stakes.

Spikeless golf shoes are required.

Thank you for following the pace of play policy outlined by the Starter.

LIGHTNING POLICY

If lightning is in the area, the Player Assistant will sound a horn. It is the responsibility of the players to return to the clubhouse to seek shelter. Our Guest Service staff will inform players when it is safe to return to the course where they stopped play.

YARDAGE

All yardages on tees and sprinkler heads are measured to the center of the green.
